Mission Statement:



The New Milford Volunteer Fire Department is committed to providing superior levels of quality service that exceed the public's expectations for timely and effective delivery of fire prevention, fire control and public education.

How to become a Volunteer Firefighter:

- Must be at Least 18 years of age, but not over 45 years old at the time of application
- Undergo a basic medical physical examination and meet the health guidelines of the State
- Entry into the NJ State Fireman's Association
- Final approval by the Mayor & Council

How to become a Junior Volunteer Firefighter:

- Explorer: Must be at Least 14 years of age
- Junior: Must be at least 16 years of age
- Undergo a basic medical physical examination
- Final approval by the Mayor & Council



Training and Firefighting Activities:



Practice makes perfect — Drilling in Fire Fighting & Rescue Techniques

- Initial Instruction at the Bergen County Law & Public Safety Institute encompassing 150 Hours of formalized classroom and practical training (2 Nights per week for 50 Classes).
- Five certificates will be issued following completion of this course, including Firefighter I, Hazardous Materials Awareness, IMS-I-100, Hazardous Materials Operations, and WMD Awareness.
- Monthly Company Drills, Quarterly Mutual Aid Drills, individual training on an as needed basis.
- Optional advanced courses for specialized skill development, including hazardous materials, water rescue, extrication, building construction, public safety and more.
